### IMPORTANT- RULES FOR MAKING UP A MATCH

1. The Make Up Agreement Form MUST be signed by BOTH teams' Official of record and submitted to the NCYSA State Office before the match can be played. Once the form is signed, submitted and the match played, then the result is binding.
2. It is both teams' responsibility to make sure fields are secured through the home association's field coordinator, and that the field is the appropriate size for the age group, lined, goals anchored etc. Local Association and State office clearance is needed for a make up match.
3. It is both teams' responsibility to make sure officials are secured through the home association's Certified Referee Assignor and to pay for the officials using the established Classic Match Fee's. Failure to properly secure officials or the use of uncertified officials will void the match results.
4. It is the teams' responsibility to provide the NCYSA state Office with a record of the match played, within **48 hours** of completion of the match. The record should be kept on the original match report.
5. If one team challenges the validity of the results of the make up match, then it is THAT team's responsibility to provide evidence of unethical actions within **48 hours** of the match.
6. **TEAMS ARE REQUIRED TO MAKE UP COUNTING GAMES, BOTH TEAMS MUST BE IN AGREEMENT AS TO THE MAKE UP DATE AND TIME.** If teams cannot agree to a makeup date and time, then NCYSA will: (1) reschedule the game arbitrarily; and/or assign double forfeits.
