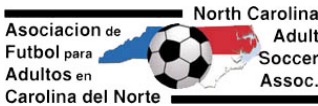
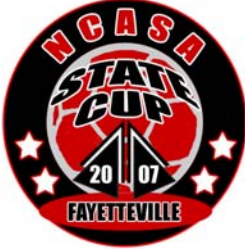

TEAM ENTRY & PLAYER REGISTRATION DEADLINE	Friday, November 9th, 2007 (Postmarked) \$ 50.00 late fee applied after deadline. <i>All non-guest players <u>MUST</u> be on the Team's NCASA stamped Roster by this date to qualify for the Team's State Cup Tournament Roster.</i>
FINAL ROSTER DUE	Monday, December 3rd, 2007 <i>Last day for NCASA to have received final version of your team's Team's State Cup Tournament Roster with existing players from your NCASA stamped roster and/or NCASA registered guest players. (Faxes allowed with confirmation.)</i>
SCHEDULE	Teams will be guaranteed 3 matches and schedules will be posted online after: Thursday, November 15th, 2007
ELIGIBILITY	Teams must be registered and in good standing with the NCASA. Players must possess their current NCASA player pass. Guest players registered with NCASA are allowed. <u>Refer to the rules for Roster Requirements.</u>
REGISTRATION	Fill out the NCASA Team and Player Registration Form and return it with the Entry Fee and Performance Bond to the North Carolina Adult Soccer Association office postmarked by the entry deadline: November 9th, 2007.

ROSTER REQUIREMENTS

SPECIFIC TO AMATEUR DIVISIONS

- Professional players (domestic, international and foreign born) **MUST** demonstrate approved Amateur Reinstatement from US Soccer to participate. NO EXCEPTIONS.

SPECIFIC TO OPEN DIVISIONS

Professional players are only eligible to play with PROFESSIONAL STATUS in the OPEN DIVISION. NO EXCEPTIONS.

FOR MEN'S DIVISIONS

- Teams and players must be registered and in good standing with the NCASA.
- All players **must** possess their current NCASA player passes for the duration of the tournament to participate. To register or to add new players to new or existing teams, teams must register through their local association, not NCASA.
- Registration will not be allowed at the tournament.
- Teams participating in the NCASA State Cup must be comprised of the players that represent this team in current league play. (Fall 2007)
- A minimum of 9 players from your current roster is required.
- Team rosters will consist of a **maximum** 20 players, including guest players.
- A maximum of 5 guest players are allowed.
- Guest players can only come from the same NCASA affiliated league as the team.
- All guest players and player transfers must be go through your local association.
- Guest players must be currently registered NCASA players and possess their current player pass. **Out of State registered players are not permitted to play in any division of the NC Adult State Cup.**
- Players may register in two separate divisions
- Team's NCASA stamped league rosters must be submitted along with Registration by entry deadline, **November 9th, 2007**, 2007.
- Rosters will be frozen **December 3rd, 2007**. NCASA will provide a State Cup Tournament Roster upon your team completing the attached Team Roster Form.

SPECIFIC TO WOMEN'S DIVISIONS

- Teams and players must be registered and in good standing with the NCASA.
- All players **must** possess their current NCASA player passes for the duration of the tournament to participate. To register or to add new players to new or existing teams, teams must register through their local association, not NCASA.
- Registration will not be allowed at the tournament.
- These teams are not bound to a league roster therefore teams are allowed to be created for the purpose of participating in the State Cup.
- Team rosters will consist of a **maximum** 20 players.
- Players can only come from the same NCASA affiliated league as the team.
- Out of State registered players are not permitted to play in any division of the NC Adult State Cup.**
- Players may register in two separate divisions
- Team's NCASA stamped league rosters must be submitted along with Registration by entry deadline, **November 9th, 2007**, 2007.
- Rosters will be frozen **December 3rd, 2007**. NCASA will provide a State Cup Tournament Roster upon your team completing the attached Team Roster Form.

VOLUNTEERISM **Assisting the Tournament**

What: Each Team is to provide two (2) hours of assistance to the tournament. Teams can “buyout” with a \$25 contribution from their bond.

How: Essentially each team can designate 1-2 individuals to provide a maximum total of 2 hours of assistance to the tournament on behalf of their team. The individuals don't need to be players on the roster. The tournament will make every effort to make sure that the time spent helping doesn't conflict with being able to watch/participate in matches.

When: Teams MUST provide names of the individual(s) assisting by the final roster freeze date of **December 3rd, 2007**, along with a mobile phone number, or \$25 will be assessed from their bond. Sign up with be first come, first serve via email only once the schedule for assistance is posted on the NCASA website with the match schedule.

Why: The assistance that is being asked of teams is not meant to be difficult or overly labor intensive. Simply speaking, it is intended to help tournament organizers be more involved with the ongoing tournament coordination and its application of the rules.

Some Examples of Assistance

- Friday night set up and registration.
- Distributing match reports to officials before matches.
- Collecting match reports after matches and turning them into the tournament headquarters.
- Collecting loose balls during/after matches for referees.
- Field clean up after matches.

NATIONAL CUP INFORMATION

The National Cup Competition is the oldest and most prestigious soccer tournament in the United States for any person who is a member of a team playing in a league of four or more teams affiliated with the United States Soccer Federation and the United States Amateur Soccer Association.

The competition began in 1914 for the Men's Open Cup. In 1923, the Men's Amateur Cup was added. In 1980 the Women's Amateur and Over 30 Cups were begun.

Each year, some 250 teams across the United States participate in the National Cup Competition. 250 Teams! Of these, only 8 teams will become a National Champion in one of the 8 following divisions:

Men's Competitions:	Women's Competitions:
Open Cup	Open Cup
Amateur Cup	Amateur Cup
Over 30 Cup	Over 30 Cup
Under 23 Cup	Under 23 Cup

All teams that wish to play in the National Cup must play in state qualifying matches to advance to their regional competition. All teams that enter into state qualifying must pay the National Cup entry fee in addition to the state's tournament costs.

National Cup Fees

Open Divisions:	\$225
All Other Divisions:	\$175

Rules for Regionals

The Region 3 National Cup competition is held on the last weekend of May each year. The team representing the state will have to comply with USASA National Cup rules of play and roster requirements, including:

- International Clearance – required for all foreign-born NCASA registered players. The form must be completed and submitted to NCASA no less than 31 days prior to the first day of Region 3 matches for USSF to have enough time to request and RECEIVE clearance from the player's home country.
- Amateur Reinstatement – required of players with professional status competing in non-Open Cup competitions.
