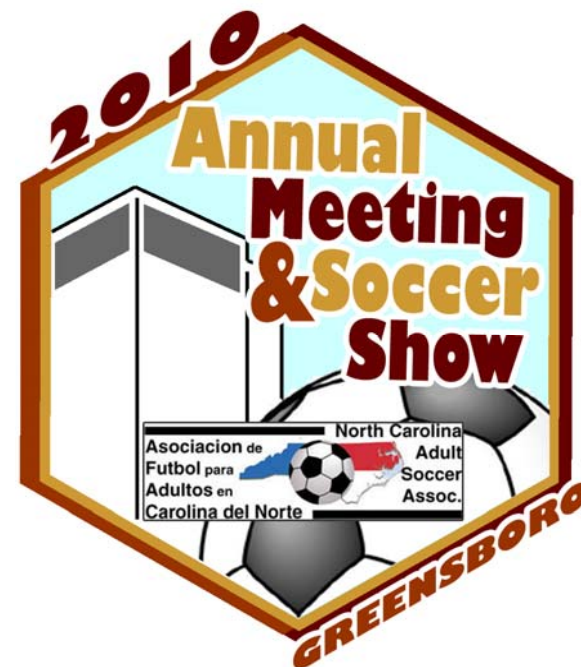

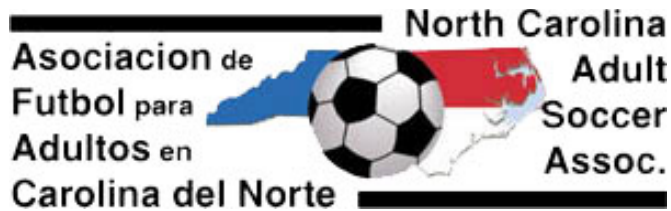

Election of NCASA Officers: 2010 Nomination Form

Summary of Election Process & Officer Positions

ARTICLE II Section 3

The election of officers will take place at the Annual General Council Meeting (AGM). Officers will take office on the day after their election. They may succeed themselves in office. Their terms of office will be:

President – 2 years	Executive Vice-President – 2 years
Secretary – 2 years	Vice President/Development – 2 years
Treasurer – 2 years	Regional VP./Calendar – 2 years
Registrar – 2 years	Regional VP/FIFA – 2 years
	Discipline & Appeals Chair – 2 years

Elected in **odd** numbered years: President, Vice President/Development, Regional Vice-President/Calendar, Secretary and Registrar.

Elected in **even** numbered years: Executive Vice-President, Regional Vice President/FIFA, Treasurer and Discipline and Appeals Chairman.

To be elected to office it shall be necessary to receive a majority of the votes cast. Nominees must be in good standing.

Summary of Nomination Process

ARTICLE II Sections 4 & 5

S4 At least sixty (60) days before the election, the Association President shall appoint a Nominating Committee with the advice and consent of the Executive Committee. It shall consist of a chairman and four other members.

Names and addresses of the members of this committee will be given to the delegates when they are notified of the Annual General Meeting.

S5 The Secretary will notify all Council members of the slate of officers submitted by the nominating committee ten (10) days before the election.

ARTICLE IX of the
NCASA Constitution
AMENDMENTS

Amendments to this constitution shall be made at any meeting to the Council of the North Carolina Adult Soccer Association where a quorum is present by a two-thirds vote of the representatives present. Proposed amendments must be submitted in writing to the Secretary at least thirty (30) days in advance and the representatives to that meeting mailed a copy with the meeting notice fourteen (14) days in advance.
