RE: Field Insurance Coverage for training - Clarification

On the “Phase II: What does that mean to NCYSA Membership” webinar, I was asked to clarify with our insurance provider the liability coverage for fields that were not currently on file for certification since some of you are restricted from using municipality fields.

There are two responses:

1. Use of personal property (someone’s home/property)
This could not be sanctioned for training by NCYSA therefore, it would not be covered by liability insurance. The liability is too great. Players could be exposed to animal bites, pools, surfaces that could cause injury, SafeSport, etc.
2. **Soccer field(s) you secure for use until your municipal field(s) are available and your association has not applied for a certificate of insurance:**
This field can used with the liability insurance in effect. NCYSA would recommend you visit our website and submit a request form for a certificate as soon as possible.
